


"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten son, that everyone who believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

The sanctuary God commanded be built was a replica of the real sanctuary in heaven. It shows how sin is dealt with and how it cannot

be ignored. The law cannot be changed to make the sinner not guilty. Sins must be paid either by the sinner receiving eternal death or by the blood of Jesus Christ who died on the cross.

1 Kings 8:27, Exodus 25:8-9, Romans 6:1-2,23, Matthew 5:17



When a sinner was convicted of sin and wanted to confess they would come to the door of the courtyard with their sacrifice. They would lay their hands on the head of the innocent victim, confess their sins and

then would kill the animal themself. This was to impress upon the sinner that their sins would finally require the death of the spotless Lamb of God.

Some of the blood is then caught by the priest, the remainder is spilt onto the ground and then the animal is burnt on the alter. The blood captured is then transferred into the holy place by the priest who would first cleanse himself at the laver.

Inside the tabernacle the smoke of the incense represents the intersession of the Holy Spirit, making our prayers of confession acceptable to the Father. The blood is then sprinkled before the veil, thus transferring the guilt from the sinner to the tabernacle and this would accumulate throughout the year until the Day of Atonement. Leviticus 4:16-17, Romans 8:26-27

On the Day of Atonement the high priest takes two perfect young goats and cast lots to determine which one would be the Lord's goat and which would be the scapegoat. The sins of the entire congregation would be transferred to the Lord's goat and killed. The blood would be sprinkled on the mercy seat (lid) of the ark of the covenant which contains the Ten Commandments, Aaron's budded rod and a small pot of manna located in the most holy place. Leviticus 16, Exodus 25:16-17,16:33, Numbers 17:10

The high priest would then transfer those sins to the alive goat (scapegoat) and it would then be led away into the wilderness and set free.

Anyone that is unrepentant, holds onto grudges, rejects Jesus or goes against God (i.e. during the time of the mark of the beast) will be condemned for eternal destruction in hell's fire. This
